

# The St. John's Jesuit Campus Overview

St. John's Jesuit is located on 54 acres of land. The cross on the top of the chapel is an easily recognizable landmark. The school is comprised of technologically advanced classrooms, cutting edge indoor athletic and arts areas and beautiful outdoor athletic facilities for both practice and competition.



The interior of the school shows an emphasis on art and an intertwining of scenes of Sacred scripture as well as the rich history of the Society of Jesus.



## Carty Fox Commons

The Carty Fox Commons focuses on providing our students with an engaging space for relaxation and socialization. Designed and formatted to function much like a college student union, the area features a student lounge with comfortable furniture, an eating and gathering area, a food court, a fireplace and a gaming area. The Sawicki Family Music Center, McQuade Theater and Titan Spirit Store are all conveniently located in the central student gathering place.

The food area offers a wide variety of options. Healthy options for lunches and food for after school activities are provided. A grill area offers breakfast as well as healthy lunchtime alternatives. Food service starts before school for breakfast and stays open to accommodate after-school activities.

With nearly all our students staying after school for activities and athletics, the Carty Fox Commons provides a comfortable space to read, catch up on homework or play a game of cards with fellow Titans. Natural light from a full bank of windows and a fireplace makes the area conducive to relaxing for a few minutes after a busy day of academics.

## McQuade Theater

The renovated McQuade Theater accommodates drama and musical productions and serves as a multi-purpose lecture hall.

## Sawicki Family Music Center

The Sawicki Family Music Center includes separate rooms for choral and instrumental rehearsal as well as individual practice rooms with state-of-the-art technology.

## Lyden Fitness Center

The Lyden Center is a 4,000 square foot fitness area that accommodates up to 100 people at one time. This area is used by all St. John's Jesuit competitive athletic teams to implement strength training sessions. Gains in strength, flexibility and stamina help each athlete develop his athletic talent to the fullest as well as help protect him from injury.

The weight training and cardiovascular stations are also used by physical education classes and are available for individual training, which helps contribute to healthy, lifelong fitness habits. Professional trainer Dr. Dustin Winkler works with both individual and groups of students.

**The Auxiliary Gymnasium** is used for several intramural programs and winter sports practices. Preseason training for spring sport also benefit from this indoor space.

The SJJ Wrestling program also utilizes a **Renovated Wrestling Room** in the Lyden Center, which features a larger space for the Titan wrestlers with improved ventilation and lighting systems.

## Lyden Field

Lyden Field is a state-of-the art facility utilized by many of St. John's Jesuit athletic teams. Thanks in part to the vision and personal contribution of Board of Trustees chairman W. Geoffrey Lyden III, Lyden Field become a reality in 2012. .



"Academics is the core of St. John's, but a strong athletic program is also a necessity for a well-rounded Jesuit education," Mr. Lyden said. "If you are pursuing excellence it needs to be evidenced in every part of your program. Strong facilities foster that."

## TV-4 Studio

TV-4 is a student-run organization operating on a closed-circuit system within the school building. Its main function is to broadcast the daily morning announcements as well as feature videos for various sports and other school-related extracurricular activities.

Students in TV-4 have at their disposal a professional news set and camera equipment, separate video and sound mixing boards, and several high-end video editing computer programs. Students of all grade levels contribute to the broadcasts, which are also posted daily for parents and alumni to view on <https://www.youtube.com/user/SJTV4/videos>.



In addition to the experience gained, some students have received college scholarships in recognition of their abilities both in front of the camera and behind the scenes.

## The Technology Wing

This 16,600-sq. ft. wing includes iMac Lab open for student use, a publications lab, and the Iott Resource Center are great adjuncts to the learning process. A broadcasting studio offers a professional studio and plenty of opportunities to gain broadcasting experience. In addition to the iMac Lab, there are two computer labs in this wing, one of which is home to the Language Lab. Students can also check out laptops for use in the Iott Center and WiFi is available campus-wide.

## Engineering Technology Lab

A second-floor technology lab with 30 multi-media computers includes complex Design Academy software used for computer-aid design in the Engineering career exploration course. This software is the same utilized by the School of Engineering at The Ohio State University.

## Fox Music Technology Lab

This college-designed lab rivals that of many colleges and universities and offers complete digital editing, recording, professional sequencing, and editing software.
